Our constraints are more stark relative to other countries



GREEN PLAN

Dense urban landscape

- Small, low-lying, island citystate of ~725 km2
- High population density of 8,000 per km2
- Competing land and infrastructure needs



Alternative-energy disadvantaged

- Limited land area •
- Low wind speeds, low tidal • range, lack of geothermal resources, no large river systems for hydropower



Export-oriented and Open Economy

- Trade = 3x GDP
- Lack of natural resources and hinterland
- Manufacturing as a key . anchor of our economy
